Admission to M.A. / M.Sc. Courses (Academic Session 2023-2025) in Anthropology, Botany, Chemistry, **Education, Microbiology and Zoology**

(General Terms and Conditions)

The candidates who have passed the B.A. / B.Sc. (Honours) Examination in the year 2023, 2022 and 2021 only are allowed to apply for admission to M.A. / M.Sc. Courses in Anthropology, Botany, Chemistry, Education, Microbiology and Zoology for the Academic Session 2023-2025.

- The 80% seats in each of the above-mentioned six subjects are reserved for the candidates who are graduated in the year of 2023 from the West 2. Bengal State University (WBSU), Barasat, WB. Merit list will be prepared strictly on the basis of the merit point (Percentage of total marks obtained in Core course + DSE course) of B.A. / B.Sc. (Honours) Examination, 2023.
- The remaining seats (20%) will be available to the B.A. / B.Sc. (Honours) graduates of other UGC recognized Universities, all back year candidates (passed in 2022& 2021) and the rest of WBSU candidates, who could not make it to the 80% merit list. Merit list will be prepared strictly on the 3. basis of the merit point (Percentage of total marks obtained in Core course + DSE course) of B.A. / B.Sc. (Honours) Examination.
- No admission test will be taken for the candidates of non-WBSU students. Merit list of other UGC recognized universities will be prepared on the 4. basis of Percentage of total marks obtained in Core course + DSE course of the B.A/B.Sc (Honours) Examination, 2023.
- If 80% seats reserved for WBSU students remain unfilled, those may filled up with the undergraduate of other universities. Similarly, if the 20% 5. seats reserved for the students from other universities remain unfilled, those may be filled up with the students of WBSU.
- The 80% and 20% seats have separate reservation quota as per the Government norms for SC, ST and OBC candidates in each subject. The SC, ST and OBC (A & B) candidates belonging to the State of West Bengal only will be eligible for this benefit and SC, ST and OBC (A & B). Candidates of 6. other States of the country will be treated at par with the candidates belonging to General category.
- The 03% seats of each subject are reserved for the Physically Challenged (Divyang) candidates. 7.
- The list of all eligible candidates for both WBSU (80%) and other University (20%) category will be available in College Website. 8.
- The Provisional Merit List of WBSU category for 80% seats in each subject will also be published in the College Website. 9.
- Similarly, Provisional Merit List for 20% Category will be prepared and subsequently published in the Website. 10.
- Only those candidates who have cleared all the papers of subsidiary subjects of all UG semesters will be considered eligible for the application of PG courses. No PNC candidates (candidates who are yet to clear any paper of subsidiary subjects in UG exams) will be allowed to take admission 11. in PG courses.
- There is no application fee for the candidates (applicable only for session 2022-23 seeing COVID-19 pandemic situation). 12.
- 13. Refund Policy of the admission fee and caution money: This policy is guided chiefly by the UGC norms in addition to the mandates, if any, from the Government of West Bengal. No refund could be made of the amount, which the college has already deposited through the treasury route. Application for the refundable amount only can be entertained till the time Semester I come to its close, subject to the multiple conditions, which naturally come in for consideration under the present reference.
- The Candidates who will be outside the published admission lists must log in on the Admission portal and register their show of interest for 14. admission by availing the "SHOW INTEREST" function on their dash board.
